Better Sleep Tips: Try one or more of the following approaches before you take a sleep aid. Over time, they may be your ticket to a good nights rest.

- Stay on schedule—Go to bed and get up at the same time every day. Can't sleep? Leave the bedroom and do something restful such as reading until you feel sleepy.
- Make changes in your bedroom. Block out nise and outside light. Make sure the room temperature is comfortable.
- Eat and drink wisely. Avoid or minimize alcohol, caffine and nicotine, as they can affect sleep. Do not eat heavily within several hours of bedtime.
- Exercise regularly
- Get natural light. A study at the University of Illinois found that people exposed to natural light at work slept better and longer.
- Turn off E readers and other devices 2 hours before bed. They can emit blue light which suppresses levels of melatonin, the hormone that regulates sleep.
- Reduce stress with meditation.
