There are drop off boxes throughout the church for your items. Money donations are also welcomed to help with shipping cost, or we can use the money to buy items to fill more boxes. A small

shoebox can have a big impact on a child. What goes into the box is fun, but what comes out of it is eternal. Be a part of changing lives through the power of a simple gift.

## Gift Suggestions:

**TOYS:** Include items that children will immediately embrace such as dolls, toy cars, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, balls, toys that light up and make noise (with extra batteries), etc.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES: pens, pencils and sharpeners, crayons, markers, notebooks, paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.

NON-LIQUID HYGIENE ITEMS: toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, washcloths, etc. ACCESSORIES: t-shirts, socks, hats, sunglasses, hair clips, jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries), etc.

A PERSONAL NOTE: You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. If you include your name and address, the child may be able to write back.

**DO NOT INCLUDE:** Used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; chocolate or food; out-of-date candy; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

Oct. 9: School supplies (pens, pencils, paper, crayons, etc.)

Oct. 16: Personal hygiene items (combs, soap, washcloths, toothbrushes/paste)

Oct. 23: Toys/games-small cars, dolls, jump ropes

Oct. 30: Socks, t-shirts, hair bands, flashlights

Nov 6: Hard candy & bubblegum
